Things to Remember...

#### MATHS

#### <u>ENGLISH</u>

In English, we will be developing the children's sentence writing and imaginative story telling through 'Drawing Club' sessions inspired by 'Bananaman' and 'Stuck', as well as the traditional tale of 'The Hare and the Tortoise'.

In Reception, our focus will be on writing sentences with increased independence, using our phonic knowledge to sound out and write words.

In Year 1, our focus will be on writing extended sentences, using descriptive word choices to add effect. We will be developing our independence to write a series of sentences, using both phonic knowledge and tricky word spellings too.

#### ART and MUSIC - Our Project Create - Portrait

We be learning about what makes a portrait, and studying the portraits of some wellknown artists, including Vincent Van Gogh, Picasso, Paul Klee and Andy Warhol. We will be using their styles and techniques to create our own portraits, which we will share with you at the art exhibition in term 6.

As part of our Music appreciation, we would like to ask you to share some of your favourite songs that your might listen to at home or in the car. Please write them on Tapestry and we will make our class play list using out Alexa!

During Maths this term, we will be focussing on Position and Direction, learning about prepositions and positional language whilst reading 'Rosie's Walk' by Pat Hutchins. We will also be learning about the concept of Mass and Weight during the Summer Term. The children will learn how to use balance scales and electronic scales, even leaning how to weigh some items in grams! We shall also be exploring the concept of Capacity throughout the summer, thinking about how much water we can fit inside a container.

#### <u>SCIENCE</u>

In Science this term, we will be learning about plants, by planting our own seeds and flowers. We will see what happens when we give them sun, soil and water.

We will also be learning about the life cycle of a butterfly. We will be watching our own caterpillar eggs hatch and grow, and see their final transformation from chrysalis into butterflies!

# <u>P.S.H.E</u>

In PSED we will be learning about oral hygiene, and learning about the importance of brushing our teeth to keep them healthy. Please share your pictures of you brushing your teeth at home via Tapestry.

We will also be reflecting on our year at school and celebrating our fantastic achievements!

## <u>RE</u>

We will be reading some of the stories about Jesus and thinking about how he was a leader and a teacher. We will be thinking about people we see as leaders and teachers in our own lives. We will be learning a song about Jesus and adding actions.

#### PHONICS

Reception will be continuing to learn to recognise 'digraphs' including ai, oi, ar and er. Year 1 will be learning the different ways to make the long vowel sounds, including A = ai, ay, a\_e.

# Transition time

Over the Summer term, we will be preparing the reception children for year 1 by developing their independent work time, attending assemblies and visiting their next classroom. We will be taught some phonic sessions with our new teacher and spending some time in the Squirrel classroom. There will also be time for the children starting school in September to come and explore our environments too.

#### <u>P.E.</u>

In PE this term, we will be focussing on preparation for Sports Day. We will be developing our skills needed for the different events, as well competing in lots of races, trying our best and having good sportsmanship.
