Determination:

- Focus on what the teacher is saying.
- Try and volunteer answers.
- Keep trying and not giving up.

Independence:

- By having a good go on your own.
- By asking a friend before the teacher.
- By completing my work.

Respect:

- By sitting upright in my chair.
- By making eye contact and not slouching.
- By not fiddling with things on my table when the adult is talking.
- By stopping drawing /writing when the teacher is talking (unless I have permission).

Resilience:

- By showing I have kept trying even if I find something challenging.
- By being flexible to solve a problem.
- By showing more confidence in your own ability.
- By showing improved self-esteem.

Curiosity:

- To show you are fully present in your focus in the lesson or activity.
- To ask sensible questions.
- To find more than one answer to a possible question.
- To show passion to find the answer to a question.
- To research a question of topic outside of the classroom.

Pride:

- To always take pride in the presentation of your work.
- To try your best with your handwriting.
- To support the class teacher in taking pride in the class environment.
