#### ENGLISH

For our topic of castles, we shall be focussing on the story *The Egg.* The Year One children will be developing their independent sentence writing. Using capital letters, finger spaces and a full stop. Our Reception children will be learning how to recognise and write their names and to develop their mark-making skills in different media... time to get out the chalks, shaving foam and paints!

When thinking about knights, castles and dragons in our topic, we shall pursue the children's interests, and use our writing to support our learning in the environment. We will also be reading the traditional tale of Goldilocks. We will be developing our story telling skills and writing recipes to make delicious porridge!

## HISTORY

We shall be learning how to become a Historian this term. We will focus on castles, looking at naming and identifying the different parts of the castle and thinking about who might have lived there. We will be creating our own timelines looking at houses from the past and begin to learn how to analyse historical sources looking at artefacts, photographs and paintings. The Year 1 children will be visiting Lewes castle and we are hoping to have a knight visit us later in the term! In term 2 we will be learning about a famous man from the past called Guy Fawkes. We will be finding out bonfire night traditions.

#### PHONICS

Reception will be learning 2 letter sounds each week. I will send these home for you to practice. Year 1 will be recapping on their use of digraphs to read and write words, as well as reading tricky words by sight.

#### ART.

We will be creating our own castle pictures using paints and collage during our castle topic. After the half-term we shall be exploring mixed-media to create our own firework piece. When learning about Diwali we shall be creating our own Rangoli and Mehndi Patterns. During the run up to Christmas we will explore a range of Christmas crafts to make the season extra special!

#### MATHS

We shall begin to introduce some new concepts over the next two terms. Reception children will be focussing on their number recognition to 10 and then 20. Year One will be learning to read and write numbers across 100. We will begin counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s and learning about the concept of addition and subtraction.

The children will also begin to recognise and name common 2D shapes, including rectangles, squares, circles and triangles.

#### <u>SCIENCE</u>

In Science this term, we will be learning about different materials and carrying out some experiments. We will investigate what would be best materials for protecting a knight! As the weather turns, we shall start thinking about Seasonal Changes, using our beautiful school grounds to help us learn about when Summer turns to Autumn and Autumn in to Winter.

In term 2, the year 1 children will have their science lessons with the other year 1 children, with Miss Eaglen.

# <u>P.S.H.E</u>

During Term 1 the children will be getting to know their new classmates and learn about our school rules, knowing that rules keep us happy and safe. We will also be reading the colour Monster to learn about emotions.

# MUSIC & RE

We will be focusing on traditional nursery rhymes and singing songs for harvest. In RE, we will be learning about what Harvest means to Christians. We will be learning about a Christening and why this is an important celebration for Christians.
