<u>Homework</u>

Please concentrate on reading daily with your children as it really helps them to develop their reading skills and enjoyment of books. In maths, it would be useful to focus on number recognition to 100, counting forwards and backwards from any number, counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s and number bonds to 10, e.g. 4 + 6. Number bonds to 20 e.g 14 + 6 = 20. Practising writing numerals the correct way round would also be beneficial for lots of the children.


Term 4- As part of our Design Technology Grand Design focus we will be designing and making an accessible room for a home. We will be collecting shoe boxes for this.

ENGLISH

This term we will be using the lovely Oliver Jeffer's book 'The Way Back Home'. We will be looking deeply at each of the plot points, developing our use of adjectives and innovating the story to create our own narrative. We will be learning a poem 'If I lived in a Tree House' and creating our own version. In Term 4, we will be looking at non-fiction texts, focussing on the book 'What's Where on Earth?' and creating non-chronological report about habitats. The children will continue to have daily phonics lessons. Mrs Payne and Mrs Pettifer teach Year 1 phonics in class. Mrs Tomsett teaches Year 2 phonics in the Bubble.

MATHS

This term, we will be focussing on multiplication and division. Children will be learning how to group equally, understand what an array is and how to use them to help them solve multiplication and division problems. We will then learn about fractions and solve practical fraction problems involving shapes and quantities. In term 4, we will be revisiting addition and subtraction, applying our understanding to bigger numbers and Year 2 children will be adding and subtracting two 2-digit numbers. We will also be learning to solve simple problems involving money.

Project: Explore Geography Focus

Geography will be our project focus in Term 3. We will be looking at our locality and comparing homes here and abroad. We will be thinking about the difference between a house and a home. We will be exploring maps and aerial photographs. We will also be learning a song to help us remember the names of the seven continents and five oceans.

Project: Explore Design Technology Focus

DT will be our project focus in Term 4. We will be taking part in an exciting Grand Designs style project where we will be designing an accessible, future-proof room. We will be learning about what makes a home accessible and becoming creative innovators as we research, design and make our own models. Please get in touch if you have particular design skills that could help support our learning with this.



P.S.H.E

Our theme this half term is Dreams and Goals. We will be learning about goals and successes, and we will think about how it feels to set a goal and to achieve it. Our theme for Term 4 is Healthy Me. We will be learning about ways to be happy and healthy. We will explore healthy eating, medicine safety, exercise and ways to relax.

SCIENCE

This term the children will be learning about plants. The children will use our lovely outside environment to identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. They will also learn how to identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

R.E

This term we will be learning about Judaism. We will be exploring things that are precious to Jewish people and about different Jewish objects and why they are special. We will be learning about how Jewish people celebrate Shabbat. We will also be exploring why and how Christians celebrate Easter.
