What we're learning... Project: Landscape and Treasure

English: Independent sentence writing, considering our choices of words. We will also focus on our presentation and making sure others can read our writing. Where the Wild Things Are and The Oak Tree.

Maths: Number and place value, addition and subtraction, and shape.

PSHE: Resilience and relationships

PE: Kicking skills, ball control, team games and fundamental movement games
